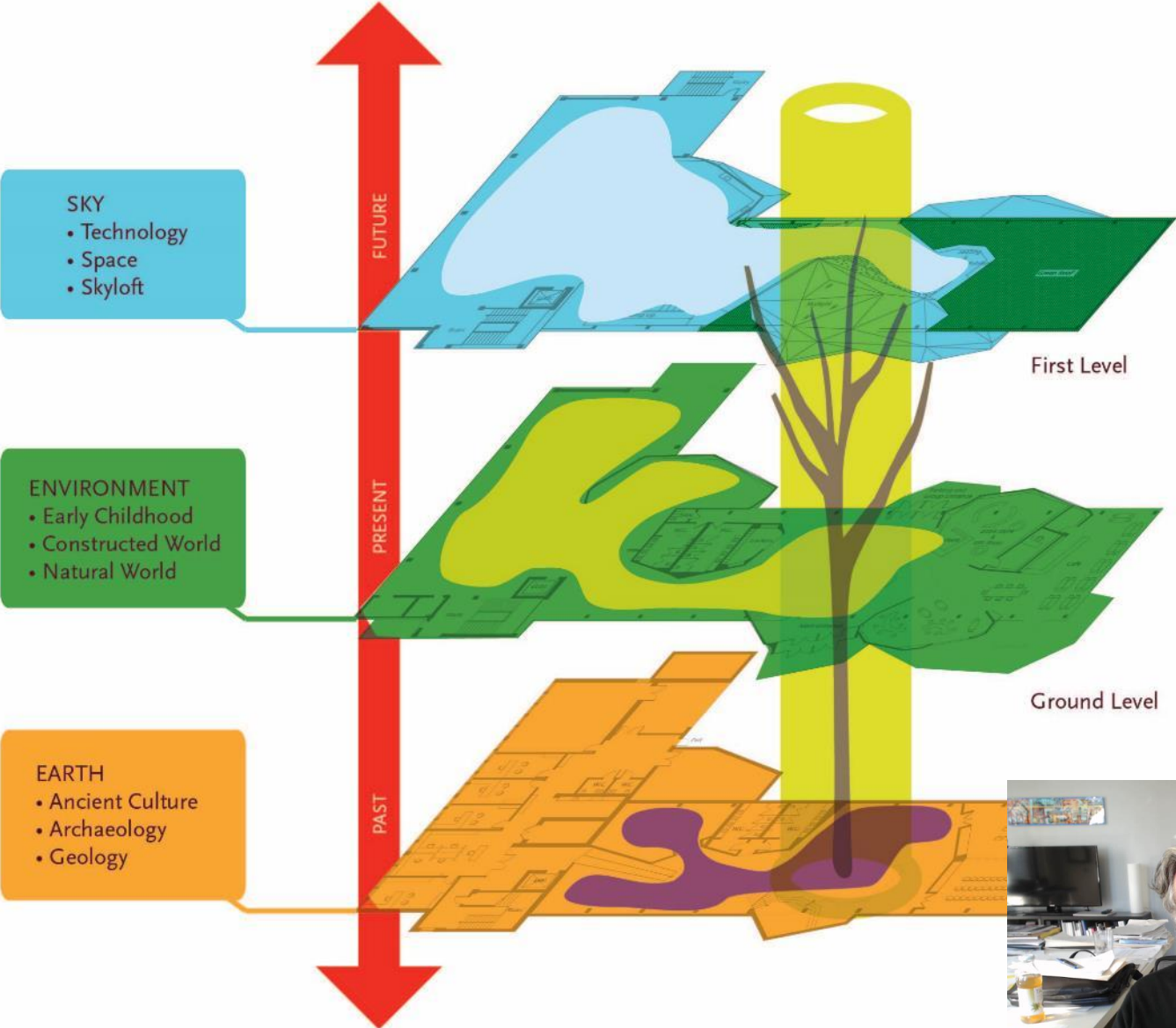


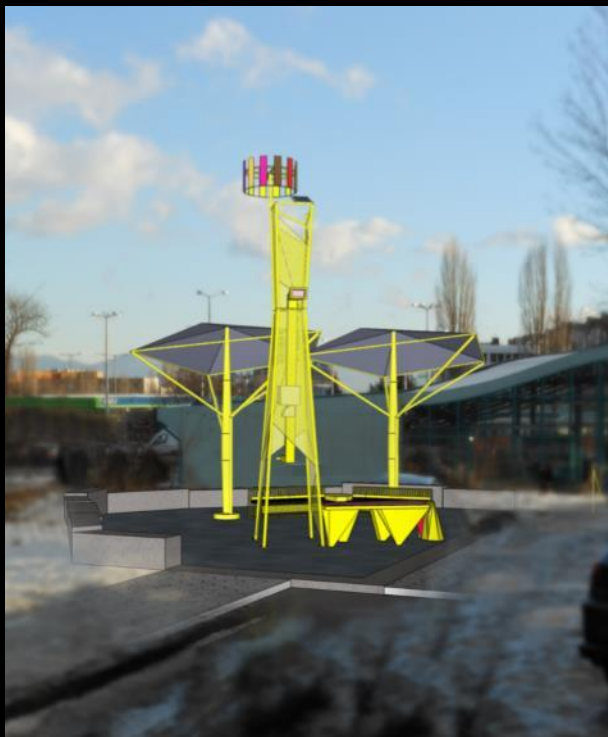
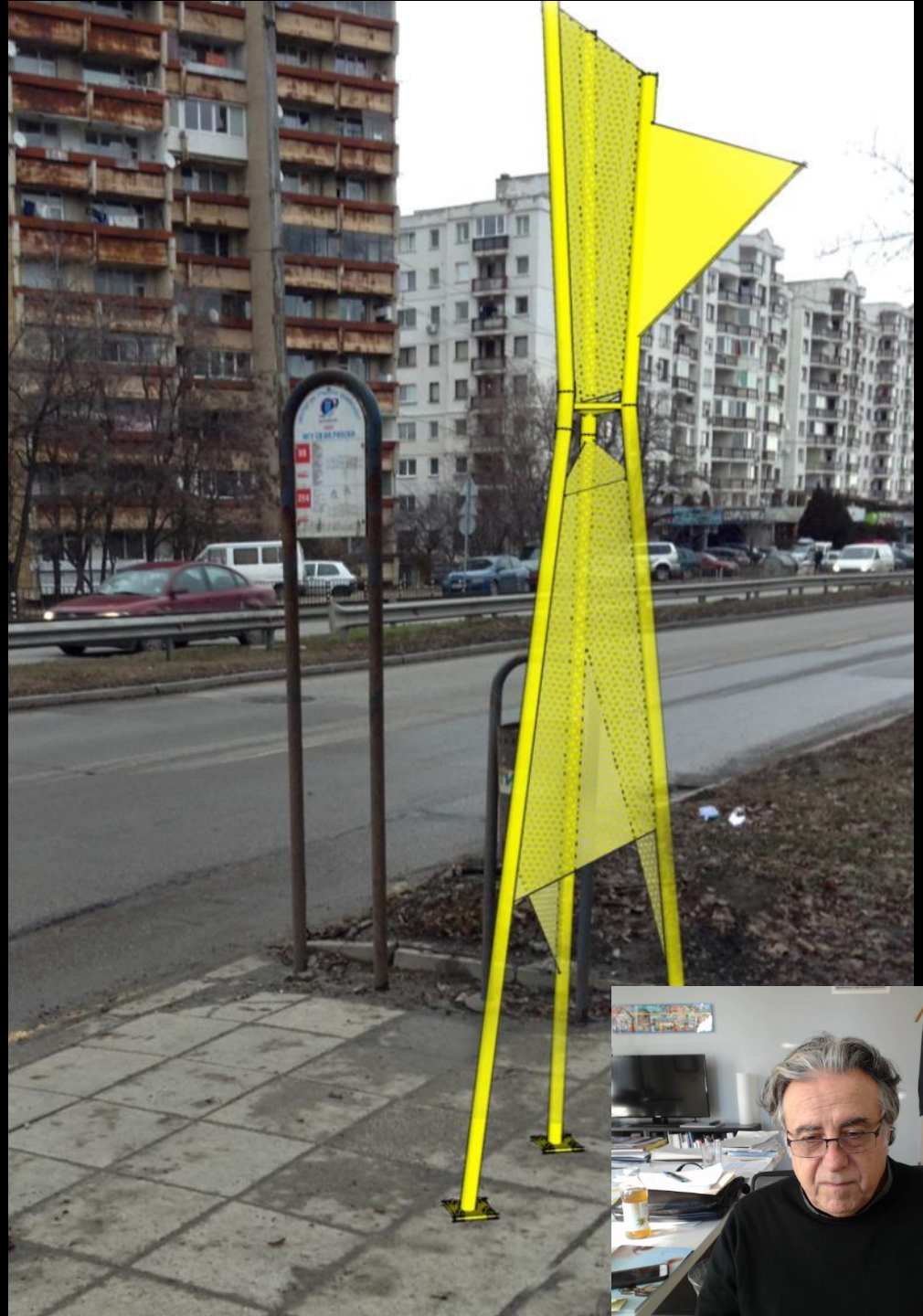


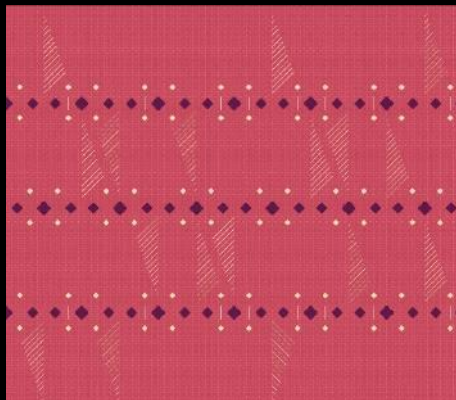
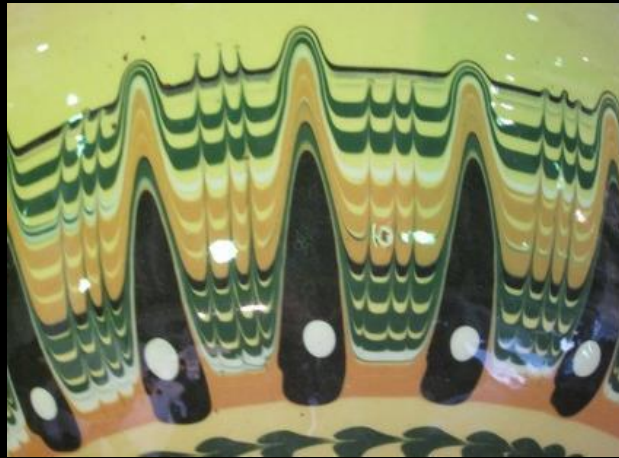




Concept Diagram

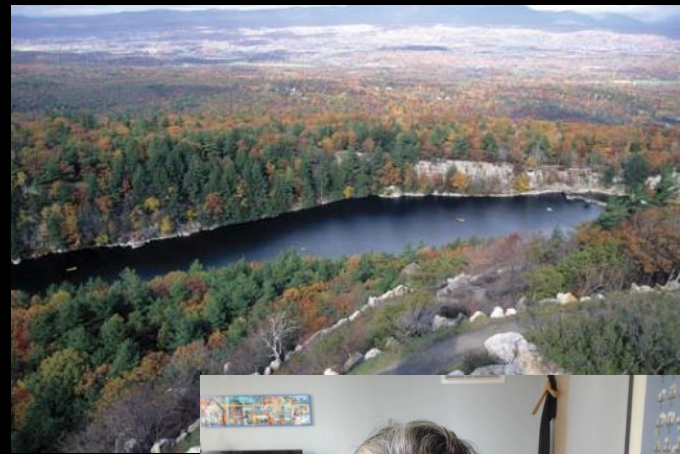

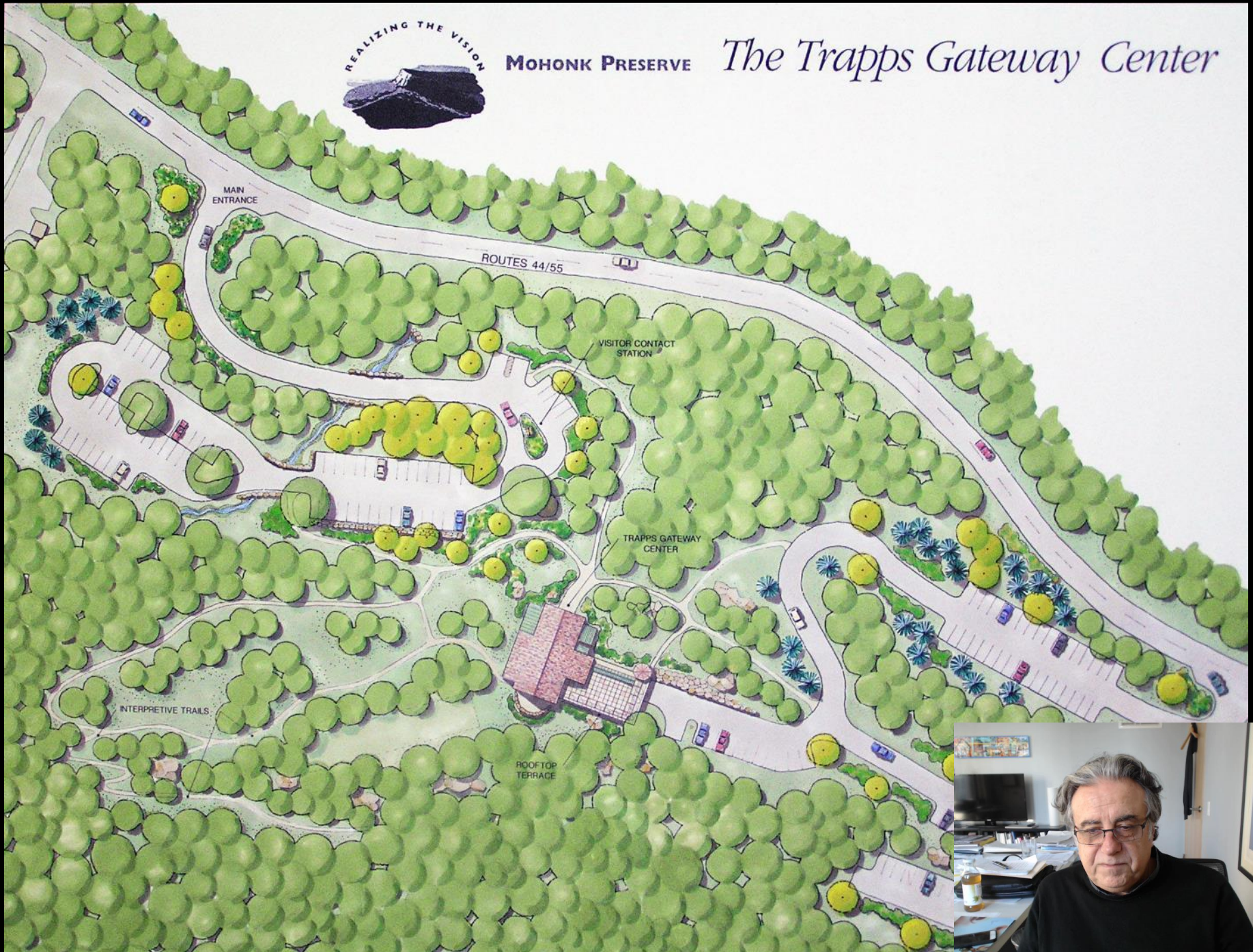


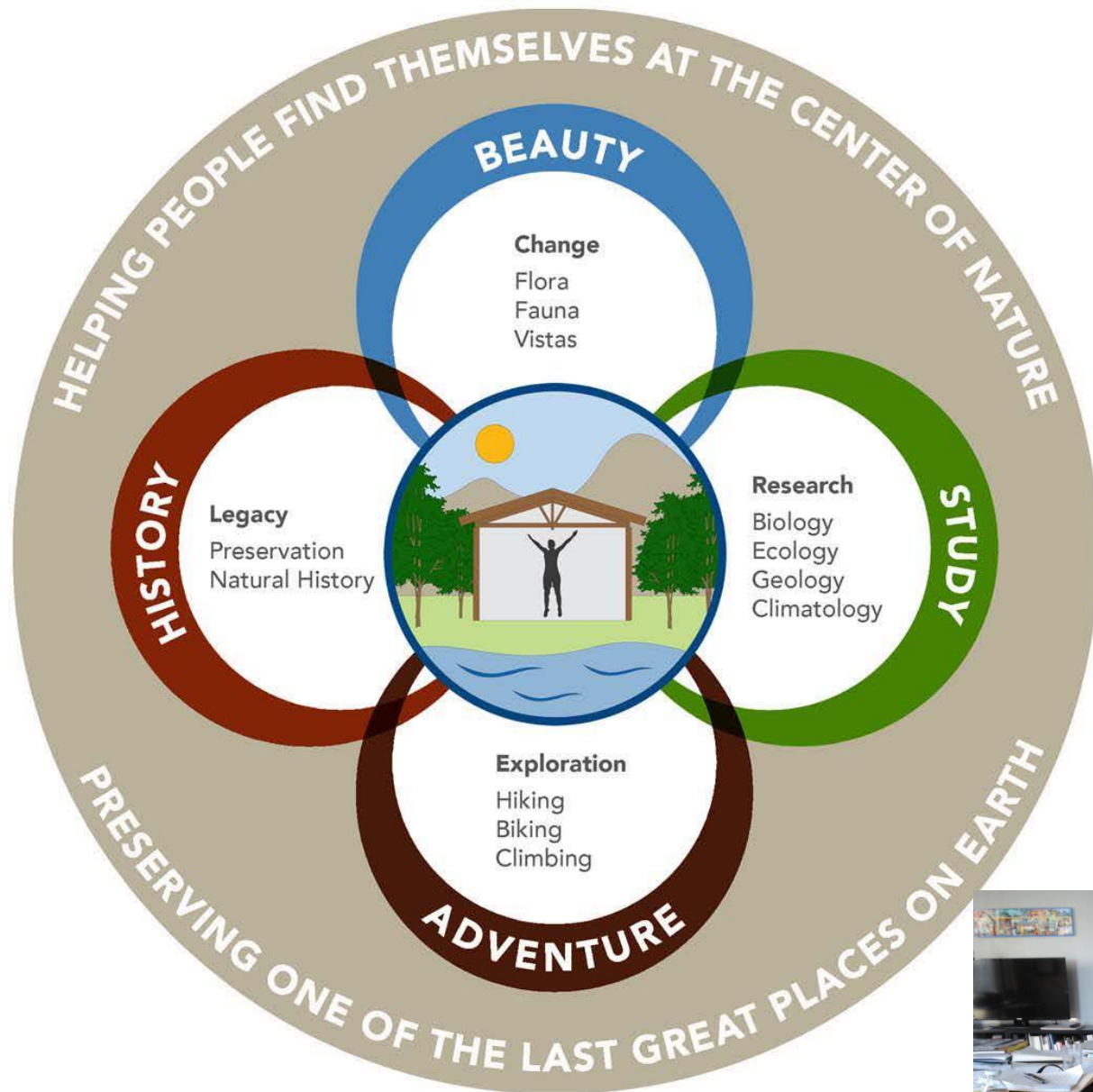

The Mohonk Preserve: Conservation for the Next Century

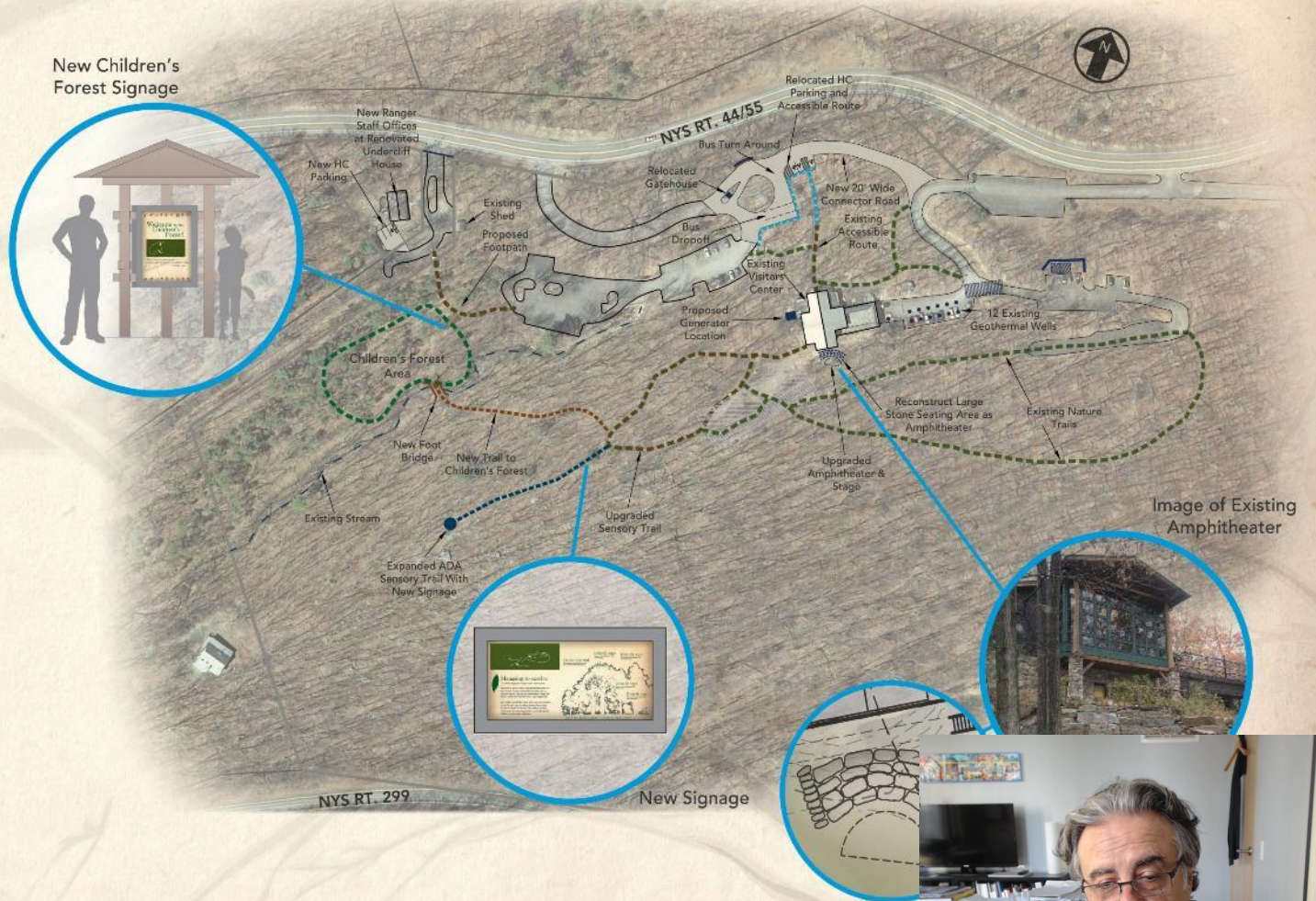
SITE PLAN

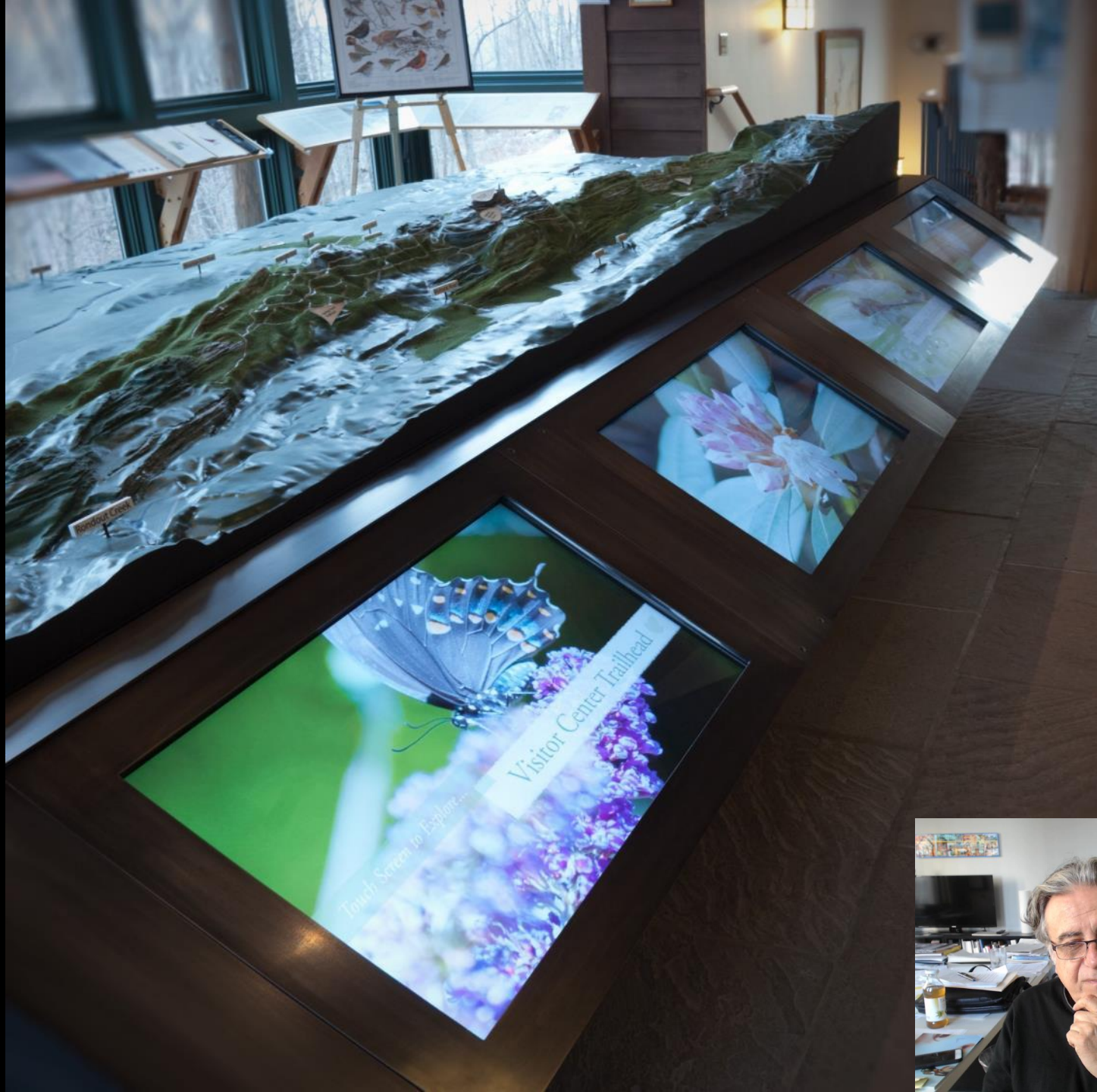
