- Open for 2-3 months, 2.5 days/ week
- Per venue appr. 1300-1800 visits, many regular visitors, long stay
- All ages, ca. 50% children between 6 and 13 years old
- Very mixed audience (educational, cultural, social background)
- Visitors speak over 30 languages
